




Responsibilities of IQA Unit, Eastern University

- Co-ordinate all QA related activities in the University;
- Implementing QA Reviews and take follow-up actions;
- Provide advice in preparation of Self-evaluation report;
- Co-ordinate all QA Activities to all Faculties / Departments;
- Organize awareness programmes on QA for the staff members;
- Contribute QA aspects into the corporate plan;
- Identification and sharing of good practices with other departments;
- Liaise with the UGC/QAA Council and other External QAA agencies;
- Ensure the academic regulations/By-Laws are in place.





- Teaching load per staff
- Percentage of PhD qualified Staff members
- Research Grants/staff member
- Publication in Indexed/International Journals

Obstacles in QA

- Lack of Lecture / Laboratories / Examination Hall
- Inadequate Laboratory equipment, consumables
- Lack of Scientific Literature
- Slow Internet facilities
- In adequate computer facilities
